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## PHILIPPINES: Cebu & Bohol 4D3N



### Day 1: Cebu arrival

Air Asia 6.10pm flight departure to Cebu, arriving 10.15pm. Transfer to hotel for check-in. Overnight in Cebu.

### Day 2: Cebu – Bohol - Cebu (B/L/D)

Morning, depart to **Bohol island by ferry**. On arrival, proceed on **Sit-In-Coach tour** (join other tourists) to visit **Chocolate Hills** (hills which look like mounds of chocolate drops!, a famous sight of Bohol), **Tarsier Sanctuary** (Tarsier is the weird looking animal with unproportional big eyes that made Bohol famous), **Baclayon Church**, **Bilar man-made forest**, **Blood Compact Marker** (where the Spanish conqueror Legazpi made a peace deal with Raja Sikatuna, the local chief) and enjoy **Loboc River Cruise with lunch**. Return by ferry back to Cebu. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Cebu.

### Day 3: Cebu (B/L/D)

Morning, start **Cebu city for private tour** covering **Magellan's Cross** (a cross planted by the first person to sail round the world and first Westerner to land in the Philippines, Ferdinand Magellan), **Basilica Minore del Santo Nino** (this site is the birthplace of Christianity in the Philippines as a wooden church built in 1565 once stood at this place) and **Fort San Pedro** (built by the Spanish).

Then visit the **Chinese Taoist Temple** of Cebu, located on high ground offering splendid views of the city. Then proceed for lunch. After lunch, some shopping time in Cebu. Then transfer to **Mt. Busay (known as TOPS)** viewpoint for sunset views overlooking Cebu city and the sea. Dinner at Top of Cebu restaurant. Overnight in Cebu.

#### **Day 4: Cebu departure (B)**

Morning, after breakfast, checkout and transfer to visit **Guitar Factory** on Mactan island (hand-crafted guitars are famous products of Cebu). Then a photo stop at **Lapu-Lapu Monument** (Lapu Lapu was the local chieftain who defeated Spanish soldiers in the 1521 Battle of Mactan, which also resulted in the death of Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan). Proceed to Cebu airport for 1.50pm Air Asia flight departure, arriving KLIA2 at 5.40pm.

**RATE:** per person, twin sharing basis, valid for travel from April 2018 to March 2019. Rates subject to peak season surcharge & compulsory gala dinners (for example X'Mas-New Year period); to be advised on booking.
